

Vivas Arquitectos

Vivas Arquitectos is an architecture practice founded in Barcelona in 2006 by César and Cristian Vivas Millaruelo. Its work is grounded in a systematic and pragmatic approach, exploring new solutions and unconventional construction systems.

The practice has received numerous recognitions, and its work has been widely published and exhibited both nationally and internationally. Among its distinctions are the 2024 CSCAE National Architecture Award and the 2025 European Matilde Baffa Ugo Rivolta Award. Its projects have appeared in prestigious publications such as *Arquitectura Viva*, *Casabella* and *Detail*, and were featured in the Spanish Pavilion exhibition at the 2025 Venice Architecture Biennale. More recently, the practice has been invited as a speaker at the UIA World Congress of Architects 2026 in Barcelona and at the Spitzer School of Architecture in New York. The partners combine their professional practice with teaching at the Universitat Politècnica de Catalunya -ETSAV and ETSAB-.



Togores
Social housing

Located in La Olivera neighbourhood of Palma de Mallorca, the Togores project, completed in 2025, comprises 30+8 social housing apartments across two buildings, with a total built area of 2,936 m² + 458 m² and a budget of €3,952,791 + €844,247. The proposal is based on a construction system using locally produced compressed earth blocks (CEB) and timber floor slabs, reducing the project's carbon footprint while reinforcing the region's construction identity. The development is organized around external walkways that promote cross-ventilation, community life, and thermal comfort.

Glòries
Social housing

Located within the urban transformation area of Illa Glòries, building C of Glòries project, completed in 2024, comprises 67 social housing apartments and commercial premises across a built area of 9,489 m², with a budget of €10,747,767. The proposal focuses on the transition between public, communal, and private space (city-community-home), articulated through a sequence of voids and intermediate spaces.

Casernas J
Social housing

Located within the urban transformation area of the former Sant Andreu quarters in Barcelona, Building Casernes J, completed in 2024, comprises 56 industrialized social housing apartments for young people across a built area of 4,895 m², with a budget of €5,215,526. The project is based on an industrialized timber construction system using 2D and 3D components. The building is organized around interior courtyards that promote cross-ventilation and natural lighting while encouraging social interaction.

Marroc
Industrialized social housing

Located in the Poblenou neighbourhood of Barcelona, the project, completed in 2024, comprises 45 industrialized social housing apartments across a built area of 4,473 m², with a budget of €5,246,986. The intervention is realized through a 3D modular construction system, comprising a total of 104 fully finished prefabricated modules that were transported and assembled on site in just 15 days.

Císter
Emergency shelter for
homeless women

Located in Sarrià-Sant Gervasi district of Barcelona, the project, completed in 2023, occupies a built area of 3,012 m², with a budget of €5,462,633. The intervention is conceived as a social and healthcare facility that prioritizes privacy, safety, and support throughout the recovery process through an individualized care model. The building features a timber structure and construction system, providing energy efficiency and a sense of warmth, while strategic openings create courtyards, porches, and terraces that enhance natural light, ventilation, and social interaction among residents.

Cal Cisó
Social housing

Located in the new La Marina del Prat Vermell neighbourhood in Barcelona, Cal Cisó project, completed in 2023, comprises 108 social housing apartments and commercial premises across a built area of 14,004 m², with a budget of €15,389,397. The proposal breaks the volume down into three buildings set on a shared base, whose landscaped roof serves as a communal space. This creates a gradual transition between the public and domestic realms through walkways and intermediate spaces that enhance both neighbourly interaction and the environmental quality of the homes.

La Chalmeta

Cooperative housing under a
right-of-use model

Located within the La Marina del Prat Vermell transformation area in Barcelona, La Chalmeta project, completed in 2021, comprises 32 cooperative homes and community facilities across a built area of 3,750 m², with a budget of €3,791,500. The project is conceived as a model of collaborative housing that fosters community life by integrating shared spaces that strengthen social relationships and a sense of belonging among residents. The homes are organized through a system of equivalent rooms, providing flexibility and a non-hierarchical distribution of domestic space.

Alí Bei

Social housing apartments for elderly people and 15 collective housing units for people at risk of social exclusion

Located on a unique block in Barcelona's Eixample district, this housing project, developed between 2016 and 2020, occupies an area of 6,019 m². With a budget of €5,998,549, the intervention is structured around two volumes that open onto a large central courtyard, with stairs and walkways acting as an elevated street. Together with the communal spaces, these elements encourage social interaction. The programme includes 49 dwellings and 15 residential units, reinforcing the project's inclusive character and its commitment to serving the community.
